8th Annual Taste of the Cape Returns to Tarpon Point Marina

Purchasing tickets in advance is recommended in order to avoid lines at the gate. It is also recommended to show up at the beginning of the event to avoid the traffic leading into Tarpon Point Marina.

All proceeds from the Taste of the Cape support the Education Committee's scholarship program and the Gulf Coast Symphony's music education and community programs. The event is being supported by the Gunterberg Charitable Foundation.

Taste of the Cape runs from 11:00am to 6:00pm on Sunday, February 6, 2022 with musical performances throughout the day. Various Bands will perform, and the Gulf Coast Symphony will present a Symphony at Sunset concert at 4:30pm. General Admission is \$10, VIP passes are \$60, with food and drink prices ranging from \$3–\$8. 100% of net proceeds from this event go directly to local student scholarships and music outreach programs in the community.
